

Uluborlu Alâeddin Mosque

Alâeddin Mosque; Uluborlu Castle, located outside the old city walls in Uluborlu. Old Uluborlu, medieval to the early years of the Republic is an important settlement area. The ruins that remain from these periods are important determining factors for the settlement of Uluborlu.

According to the inscription and resources available, Alâeddin Mosque was built in XIII. Century. The structure that exist today was build by the local people after fire, in the early XX. Century. Structure in terms of planning, has the north-south direction in a rectangular space. Harim part, divided into three sections, and the in middle sahn, there are circular and oval form of domes, in right and left sides, there are small domes. XIX.-XX.

Century in the sense of decoration, was presented in the local style.
